Because our mission involves serving children, we use the art work of children in some of our printed materials and cards. Entries will be judged by volunteers and staff of Children's Aid Society, with winning entries being used in future printed materials for Children's Aid Society.

Rules of the Contest:

- Art must reflect a sentiment or message that represents Children's Aid Society and the Christmas season (Santa Claus images will not be considered).
- Size of finished art work must be 8-1/2 x 11 inches on white paper.
- Art work must be created using colored markers, pencils, crayons or water color paints.
- Art work cannot be folded.
- Entry must be accompanied by a signed release form by the child's guardian (*please visit www.cassd.org to download the form, or contact Children's Aid Society*).
- With the entry, please include the child's name, address, telephone number and age. Children must be between ages 6 and 12 as of December 16, 2008.
- Entries must be postmarked no later than December 16, 2008.
- One entry per person.
- Entries will not be returned, and become the property of Children's Aid Society.
- Relatives of Children's Aid Society employees are not eligible to participate.
- Winning entries will be announced by February 2009.
